Application Instructions:

This application package is for **INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS ONLY** who wish to apply for the U.S. Coast Guard Academy (arriving June 24, 2019). All applications must be received at the U.S. Coast Guard Academy by March 1, 2019, so it is in your best interest to submit your application well in advance of that date. The application has three parts: Application; Essays (last page of this part), and Supplemental Forms. All parts shall be completed and delivered to your liaison at the U.S. Embassy or Defense Attaché Office. All blocks are required, please type or neatly print all information.

If something does not apply to you, simply enter "N/A". Contact your liaison if you have any questions.

To apply as an International Candidate you must be:

1) A foreign citizen (not a U.S. citizen) of sound moral character; 2) Unmarried with no dependents or financial obligation; 3) 17-22 years of age on July 1, 2019; and 4) A high school graduate or GED recipient (or will be before July 1, 2019). We cannot waive any of these requirements. If you are a U.S. citizen (including dual citizenship with another country), you must apply on-line at www.uscga.edu/apply/

Personal Statement #1 - Limit 500 words

Why do you want to attend the U.S. Coast Guard Academy and how did you decide to select your intended academic major? What are your long-term goals and how do you hope to use the education and military training you'll receive as an International Cadet?

Personal Statement #2 - Limit 500 words

The Coast Guard Academy's mission is to develop leaders of character. Discuss a time when you led a group or team through a difficult situation, and what you learned from that experience.

Description of Tattoos or Body Piercings - Limit 250 words

If you have any tattoos or body piercings; please describe them, including location on your body.

Explanation of Offense - Limit 250 words
