- I. For the Purpose of determining the eligibility of the bidders, Bidder shall submit One (1) original and Six (6) copies of the following documents using the prescribed form during Bid Opening:

A. Eligibility Documents

Class “A” Documents:

- i. PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership for procurement to be performed overseas, it shall be subject to the guidelines to be issued by the GPPB;
- ii. Statement of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid;
- iii. Statement of the Bidder’s SLCC similar to the contract to be bid, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. The bidder’s SLCC similar to the contract to be bid should have been completed within three (3) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids ;
- iv. Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) computation in accordance with ITB Clause 5.5 or a committed Line of Credit (CLC) from a Universal or Commercial Bank.

Class “B” Document:

- v. If applicable, the Joint Venture Agreement (JVA) in case the joint venture is already in existence, or duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners in accordance with Section 23.1(b) of the IRR.

Technical Documents

- i. Bid Security in accordance with ITB Clause 18;
- ii. Conformity with technical specifications, as enumerated and specified in Sections VI and VII of the Bidding Documents;
- iii. Sworn statement in accordance with Section 25.3 of the IRR of RA 9184 and using the form prescribed in Section VIII. Bidding Forms.
- iv. For foreign bidders claiming eligibility by reason of their country’s extension of reciprocal rights to Filipinos, a certification from the relevant government office of their country stating that Filipinos are allowed to participate in their government procurement activities for the same item or product.
- v. Certification under oath, certifying that they have no pending case(s) against the Government.

B. Financial Documents

- i. Financial Bid Form, which includes bid prices and the applicable Price Schedules;
- ii. Completed and signed form "For Goods Offered from Abroad" and/or form "For Goods Offered from within the Philippines", whichever is applicable.
