6th CGD MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NUMBER.....01 – 99

ILOILO RIVER SPEED REGULATION

I. <u>AUTHORITY:</u>

- 1. Republic Act 5173
- 2. Philippine Merchant Marine Rules and Regulation

II. <u>PURPOSE:</u>

To prescribe the speed limit, policy, and procedure for vessels, watercraft and fast craft entering and leaving lloilo River in order to enhance safety.

III. SCOPE:

This Memorandum Circular applies to all vessels, water craft and fast craft entering and leaving lloilo River.

IV. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

- 1. Iloilo River Navigable portion of Iloilo River from Quirino-Lopez Bridge to the mouth of the river at Farola.
- 2. Vessel/Watercraft Power driven ships and boats.
- **3. Fast Craft -Power** driven watercraft for commercial or recreational purposes with a cruising speed exceeding 20 knots.
- **4. Restricted Zone** Navigable portion of Iloilo River from back of Iloilo Custom Building to vicinity of Petron POL (Petroleum/Oil/Lubricants) Pier.

V. <u>POLICIES:</u>

- 1. All vessels / watercraft, especially fast craft when entering or leaving lloilo River are required to slow down to attain a speed made good of 4 knots or less.
- **2.** Except during emergency, vessels / watercraft and fast craft transiting the river shall maintain traffic, steer right or port to port in a meeting situation.

VI. <u>PROCEDURES:</u>

- **1.** Vessel /Watercraft and fast craft entering lloilo River shall approach perpendicular to the mouth of the river and give way to the outgoing vessel/watercraft and fast craft if there is any.
- 2. Radio contact must be maintained at all times at Channel 14 (Marine Band) between vessels/watercraft and fast craft entering and leaving lloilo River on a meeting situation or until such time that they have cleared the restricted zone or berthed.
- **3.** Vessels/watercrafts and fast craft anchor, sound and light signal shall be ready at all times when entering and leaving lloilo River.
- **4.** Tugboats towing 1 or more tow shall take extra precautions when entering or leaving lloilo River.

VII. <u>RESPONSIBILTY:</u>

- 1. Master/Patron of ships/watercraft and fast craft shall be held responsible for any loss of life and property that may be caused by deviation or non-compliance to any of the provision of this Memo Circular.
- 2. Owner/Operator shall ensure that master/patron of their vessels/watercraft and fast water craft must comply with the provisions of this Memo Circular.
- **3.** This District and Coast Guard Station Iloilo shall strictly enforce this regulation.

VIII. <u>PENALTY PROVISIONS:</u>

All vessels/watercraft and fast craft violating any of the provisions of this Memo – Circular after due process shall be imposed with the following penalty/fine.

- 1. First Offense The master/patron shall be issued a written stern warning if violation does not cause damage or lose of limb, life and property.
- 2. Second Offense The master/patron shall be issued a written reprimand and admin fine of P 2,000.00.
- **3.** Third Offense The PCG will recommend the suspension/cancellation of the Special Permit for Unlicensed Officer/Patron (SPUO) or license issued by PRC and impose double amount of admin fine.
- Fourth Offense The PCG will recommend for the cancellation of the vessel's Certificate of Inspection (CI) and Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC).
- 5. Loss of life or damage to property As a result of the vessels/watercraft and fast craft violations of the provisions of the Memo Circular shall be the responsibility of the master/patron of vessels/watercraft and fast craft concerned.

IX. PRECISSION CLAUSE:

All memorandums in conflict with this Memo – Circular are hereby rescinded.

X. <u>EFFECTIVITY:</u>

This Memorandum – Circular shall take effect upon publication.
