SUPPLEMENTAL/ BID BULLETIN NO. 01-2023

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 01-2023 is issued to include the following clarifications as integral part of the Bidding Documents for the **Early Procurement Activity for the Supply and Delivery of Fuel, Oil and Lubricants for CY-2024.**

QUESTION	ANSWER
1. Can we seek clarification as to the number of envelopes to be submitted?	<p><i>A total of 5 envelopes, one (1) original and four (4) copies.</i></p> <p>Basis: Bidding Documents</p> <p>Section VIII. Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents</p> <p>Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents</p> <p>Bidders shall submit their bids through their duly authorized representative using the forms specified in the Bidding Documents in two (2) separate sealed bid envelopes (first envelope is for technical component; second envelope is for financial component). Both envelopes shall be packaged and contained in one sealed main envelope.</p> <p>Bidders shall submit a total of five (5) main envelopes wherein one (1) original and four (4) copies. However, failure of the Bidders to submit additional envelopes shall not be a ground for disqualification.</p>
2. Can we request that the bid price reference date be on November 21, 2023? This is to give enough time for PETRON to prepare their bid documents as November 27 was declared a National Holiday.	<p>Considering the merit of the request, this is <i>approved.</i></p> <p>The bid price reference date is November 21, 2023.</p>
3. Can we request the procuring entity to provide the Project Identification No. for this bidding?	<i>ITB No. 2023-015</i>
4. For bid submission, can we manifest that an authorization letter from the company's authorized signatory be sufficient?	<p><i>No. The bidding documents are clear on this matter.</i></p> <p>Basis: Bidding Documents</p> <p>Section VIII, Technical Documents</p>

	<p>Reminder: If the prospective bidder's representative who will attend the Submission, Receipt, Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids is different from the authorized representative to do, execute and perform any and all acts necessary and/or to represent the prospective bidder in the bidding, then the prospective bidder can include the name/s of said representative in the above-mentioned proofs of authorization (e.g., original copy of the duly notarized Secretary's Certificate for corporations, Board/Partnership Resolution for partnerships, corporations, and/or joint ventures or an original copy of the Special Power of Attorney for sole proprietorships, whichever is applicable)</p>
