		Finally, Section 4.5 of Annex D of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 states that upon submission of an irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank, advance payment not to exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the contract amount shall be allowed and paid within sixty (60) calendar days from signing of the contract. The irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee must be for an equivalent amount, shall remain valid until the goods are delivered, and accompanied by a claim for advance payment.

Nonetheless, based on the guidance of the mother agency of the Philippine Coast Guard, Department of Transportation, and based on Clause 2.2 of Section V (Special Conditions of the Contract) of the Bidding Documents for the project, no advance payment shall be allowed.
