SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO. 03-2024

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 03-2024 is issued to include the following clarification/changes raised by the prospective bidders as an integral part of the Bidding Documents for the **Repowering of Port and Starboard Main Engine and Auxiliary Engine of BRP CORREGIDOR (AE-891)** detailed as follows:

Payment	Payment should be made after the completion, inspection and acceptance of the Repowering of Port and Starboard Main Engine and Auxiliary Engine of BRP Corregidor (AE-891)	The said prospective bidder propose to have a 15% Advance payment after the issuance of NTP	<p><u>REQUEST DENIED</u></p> <p>Section 4.1 of Annex D of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184 mandates that advance payment shall be made only after prior approval of the President, and shall not exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the contract amount, unless otherwise directed by the President. In exceptional cases provided for under Sections 4.3, 4.4, and 4.5 of the same Annex D of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, advance payment shall be made without prior approval by the President of the Philippines.</p> <p>Under Section 4.3 of Annex D of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, a single advance payment not to exceed fifty percent (50%) of the contract amount shall be allowed for contracts entered into by a procuring entity for the following services where requirement of down payment is a standard industry practice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Hotel and restaurant services; b) Use of conference/seminar and exhibit areas; and c) Lease of office space. <p>On the other hand, Section 4.4 of Annex D of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, provides that advance payment not to exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the contract</p>



				<p>amount, unless otherwise directed by the President, shall also be allowed for procurement of goods required to address contingencies arising from natural or man-made calamities in areas where a “State of Calamity” has been declared by appropriate authorities.</p> <p>Finally, Section 4.5 of Annex D of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 states that upon submission of an irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank, advance payment not to exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the contract amount shall be allowed and paid within sixty (60) calendar days from signing of the contract. The irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee must be for an equivalent amount, shall remain valid until the goods are delivered, and accompanied by a claim for advance payment.</p> <p>Only in the above-mentioned situations can advance payment be allowed.</p> <p>Nonetheless, based on the guidance of the mother agency of the Philippine Coast Guard, Department of Transportation, and based on Clause 2.2 of Section V (Special Conditions of the Contract) of the Bidding Documents for the project, no advance payment shall be allowed.</p>
