 - Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from the Headquarters Maritime Security Law Enforcement Command (MARSLEC) and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from Monday to Friday during office hours from **08:00 AM to 05:00 P.M.,** except non-working days (i.e., Saturday and Sunday), legal holiday, or special non-working holiday, or other nonworking days duly declared by the President, Governor, Mayor or other Government Official authorized to make such declaration.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **06 February 2025 to 26 February 2025** from the given address and website(s) below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB in accordance with the following schedule:

- 6. The procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees *in person or through email*.

The *Philippine Coast Guard* will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **14 February 2025**, **09:00 AM** at its physical address located at Headquarters Maritime Security Law Enforcement Command Conference Room, CG Base Taguig, Lot 1 ML Quezon St., New Lower Bicutan, Taguig City, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- 8. Bids must be duly received by the MARSLEC BAC Secretariat through manual submission at Headquarters Maritime Security Law Enforcement Command ConferenceRoom, Coast Guard Base Taguig Lot 1 ML Quezon St., New Lower Bicutan, Taguig City, on or before 26 February 2025, 10:00 AM. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 9. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
- 10. Bid opening shall be on **26 February 2025, 10:00 AM** onwards at the **Headquarters**Maritime Security Law Enforcement Command Conference Room, CG Base

 Taguig, Lot 1 ML Quezon St., New Lower Bicutan, Taguig City, Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
- 11. Bidders shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of their bids, and the Philippine Coast Guard will in no case, be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

Bidders should note that the Philippine Coast Guard will accept bids only from those that have paid the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents.

The Philippine Coast Guard assumes no responsibility whatsoever to compensate or indemnify bidders for any expenses incurred in the preparation of their bids.

In accordance with Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Circular 06-2005 - Tie-Breaking Method, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) shall use a non-discretionary and non-discriminatory measure based on sheer luck or chance, which is "DRAW LOTS," in the event that two (2) or more bidders have been post-qualified and determined as the bidder having the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid (LCRB) to determine the final bidder having the LCRB, based on the following procedures:

- a) In alphabetical order, the bidders shall pick one rolled paper.
- b) The lucky bidder who would pick the paper with a "CONGRATULATIONS" remark shall be declared as the final bidder having the LCRB and recommended for award of the contract.

The PCG reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
