Section VI	Schedule of Requirements	Within Sixty (60) Calendar Days (CD) from receipt of the Notice to Proceed	Request for the delivery period from Sixty (60) CD to Three Hundred Sixty (360) CD	<u>REQUEST DENIED</u> The scheduled delivery timeline is highly critical for the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) due to the current status of its ammunition stockpile. Furthermore, since the acquisition of new .50 Caliber RCWS and Machine Guns, the PCG has not procured corresponding ammunition. Thus, delivery within sixty (60) calendar days or earlier is crucial, particularly as PCG vessels are continuously deployed for Maritime Security operations in the West Philippine Sea.

The forms of Performance Security which shall be allowed to be submitted are cashier's check/managers check issued by a bank or irrevocable Letter of Credit issued by a bank. If issued by a foreign bank, it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a local bank which should be equivalent to at least five percent (5%) of the total contract price.
