This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 02-2025 is issued to include the following clarifications/changes raised by a prospective bidder relative to the competitive bidding for the **Supply and Delivery of Marine Paints and Painting Materials for Various PCG Vessels** detailed as follows:



The prospective bidder requested that the definition of Similar Contract under ITB Clause 5.3 (a) of Bid Data Sheet be modify to read "Supply and Delivery of Shipboard Supplies."	<u>REQUEST DENIED</u> We wish to reiterate that under Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A) No. 9184, procuring entities are given the discretion to clarify in the Bidding Documents the definition or description of what it considers to be "similar" project for purposes of complying with the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) requirement and eligibility criterion. Procuring Entities are in the best position to define what are considered as similar contracts as it knows the technical components needed in the contract to bid. In these cases, the definition and the relevant period of completion of the SLCC were already determined by the implementing unit as reflected in the Bidding Documents. Shipboard supplies are typically consumables that are used and depleted during regular operations.



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				<p>Examples include food provisions, lubricants, fuel, and cleaning agents while On the other hand, marine paint for maintenance is used for vessel maintenance and preservation. It is applied periodically and does not fall under daily consumable supplies.</p> <p>Thus, we cannot expand the definition of what are considered as similar contracts to shipboard supplies since it is not proportional and fit-for the purpose of the requirements of the project.</p>
