We would like to request for the amendment for Supply and Delivery of Amphibious Rescue Vehicle to be read as Supply and Delivery of Firefighting, Rescue and/or Lifesaving Vehicle/Equipment in order for SLCC to not be restrictive and limiting competition and inequitably barring the participation of capable suppliers. Hence, similarity of contract should be interpreted liberally in the that it should not refer to an exact parallel but only to analogous one of similar category under Government Procurement Reform Act or RA 9184 Section 23.4.2.4.	REQUEST IS CONSIDERED Therefore Clause 5.3 of the Section III (Bid Data Sheet) is hereby amended as follows: For this purpose, contracts similar to the Project shall include: a. Supply and Delivery of Firefighting, Rescue and/or Lifesaving Vehicle/Equipment operated by the Armed Forces of the Philippines, Philippine Government Agencies, Local Government Units, Coast Guard and/or by private entities. We would like to request that Progress Billing be applied based on the actual delivery of goods/services with corresponding payment to be made upon compliance with government accounting and auditing rules	<u>REQUEST IS CONSIDERED</u> Hence, Clause 2.2 of Section V (Special Conditions of the Contract) is hereby amended as follows: The terms of payment shall be as follows: • No advance payment is allowed. • Payment shall be made based on the following schedule: a) 99% of the amount of the goods delivered per tranche; Provided that the goods per tranche are completely delivered, inspected and accepted (Issuance of the Inspection and Acceptance Report); and b) 1% retention money which shall be released after the lapsed of the warranty period of one (1) year



					OR 100% of the amount of the goods delivered per tranche; Provided that the goods per tranche are completely delivered; inspected and accepted (Issuance of the Inspection and Acceptance Report); Provided further that the winning supplier or contractor submits a special bank guarantee issued by a bank equivalent to at least one percent (1%) of the total contract price.
