The Philippine Coast Guard now invites bids for the following procurement of:

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

Interested bidder may obtain further information from *Coast Guard Procurement Service* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from Monday to Friday, during office hours from 8:00 AM - 5:00PM.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders from 25 February 2025 to 18 March 2025 from the given address and website(s) below and upon



payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount indicated above. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees *in person or through email*.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the nonrefundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

The *Philippine Coast Guard* will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **05 March 2025**, **10:00 A.M** at Conference Room, second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Floor, Administrative Building, Philippine Coast Guard – National Headquarters, 139 25<sup>th</sup> St., Port Area, 1018 Manila shall be open to interested bidders.

Authorized representatives who are interested to attend the Pre-Bid Conference shall submit to the BAC and BAC Secretariat any document showing proof of authorization from the bidder to attend the Pre-Bid Conference (e.g., duly notarized Secretary's Certificate, Board/Partnership Resolution, or Special Power of Attorney, whichever is applicable;). Likewise, said authorized representative shall be requested to submit and/or sign a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) regarding the technical specifications and specific requirements for the project.

Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below on or before 18 March 2025, 09:00 A.M. Late bids shall not be accepted.

All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.

Bid opening shall be on **18 March 2025**, **10:00 A.M.** at the Conference Room, Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Floor, Administrative Building, Philippine Coast Guard — National Headquarters, 139 25<sup>th</sup> St., Port Area, 1018 Manila. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

Authorized representatives who shall submit the bidder's bid envelopes and attend the Opening and Preliminary Examination shall submit to the BAC and BAC Secretariat any document showing proof of authorization from the bidder to attend the Pre-Bid Conference (e.g., duly notarized Secretary's Certificate, Board/Partnership Resolution, or Special Power of Attorney, whichever is applicable;). Likewise, said authorized representative shall be requested to submit and/or sign a NonDisclosure Agreement (NDA) regarding the technical specifications and specific requirements for the project.

The Philippine Coast Guard reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
